

Primary KS2 - Koala Class - Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 2021

Subject	Autumn Term 1: Ready Steady Grow Autumn Term 2: To Infinity and Beyond!
Literacy	Individual and shared reading; O.R.T. Oxford Reading Tree, Bug Club, Fiction- Fables- comprehension questions, letter writing, addresses and dates. Non-Fiction – atlas, maps & plans - geography. Recognising high frequency words, labels & captions, sentence construction; writing labels, sentences, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts; rhymes; punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening; Letters & Sounds: blending phonemes to read words.
Numeracy	Counting, sorting, sequencing, matching, ordering, number bonds, doubles & halving, repeating addition/ multiplication; understanding symbols – addition, subtraction, real life problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, coins, length, weight and capacity using Non Standard Units of measurement and cm, mm, g, kg, ml and l., time – o’clock, half past, quarter past/to, hours and minutes, money- coin recognition, shape 2D /3D, fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$.
Science	1) Humans and animals- growing, life cycles, food, food chains 2) Space- planets, sun, earth, moon, stars, space objects
Computing	Incorporated across all subjects within the curriculum.
PSHCE	Belonging – exploring our sense of ‘belonging’ to family, friendship groups, clubs etc.
Art	1) Art- Painting- colours, mixing, lines 2) Sculpture- materials, sticking
RE	Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education- Places of Worship, Festivals and Celebrations – Autumn & Winter; Christian, Jewish, Islam, Hindu
PE/ Swimming	Swimming – Thursday L2 (currently completing Physical Management Programmes) PE- Monday L2 – Ball games and target practice and muscle stretching
History/ Geography	History- Changes of human bodies throughout their life Geography- Where we live
Music	Learn about pitch and sounds, exploring instruments, describe music using different vocabulary
Food Technology and Home Economics	Preparation of Macmillan Coffee Morning (Sep 2020), planning recipes, preparing dishes and baking cakes food and hygiene theory, learning to use equipment safely
