Subject	Autumn Term 2021
English	<p>First and Second Half Term: Class reading: “The Boy who Grew Dragons”, to include comprehension, poetry, basic grammar, writing instructions, making predictions, constructing sentences and writing stories. Phonics; spelling and grammar as applicable to each student.</p>
Maths	<p>First and Second Half Term: Counting and number recognition Matching and comparing Sorting objects according to a stated characteristic, i.e. group all the small balls together.</p>
Science	<p>First and Half Term: Forces to include – push, pull, twist, gravity, air & water resistance Second Half Term: Healthy eating to include digestive system Sound – to include the ear</p>
K&U	<p>Hertfordshire – to include where do I live, map work, history of Hertfordshire, New Town of Stevenage, Garden Cities, transport, leisure facilities</p>
Food Technology	<p>Pupils will participate in practical cooking lessons, where they follow recipes and bake/cook dishes whilst learning about and following safer working practice in the kitchen environment.</p>

PSHCE/Wellbeing	<p>First half term: Friends & relationships; equal opportunities; all about me Second half term: Citizenship; rights & responsibilities, rules; Cultural, religion & Diversity</p>
Wellbeing afternoons	<p>A rolling program of various learning activities to promote wellbeing and engagement, incl. Gardening, Art, Lego, Forest Schools, Life Skills, Social Time, Cycling and Orienteering</p>
