



KS2/3 V Class - Curriculum Overview – Spring Term 2022

Subject	Spring Term 2022
English	<p>First and Second Half Term: Spelling, punctuation and grammar: Figurative language, similes and metaphors (revision), personification. Hyperbole, alliteration, onomatopoeia Book Study 'Grandpa's Great Escape' (Rolled over from Autumn Term): plot, characterisation, setting. Compare similarities to other stories by same author and others e.g. 'Gangsta Granny'. Group reading: Audible (The Jungle Book-Mowgli stories)–Individual reading – material of choice from home or school- reading records to be kept.</p>
Maths	<p>First and Second Half Term: Rotation of the four main skills areas; Number (including place value), multiplication and division, addition & subtraction (address concept of inverse operations); Statistics; Measurement (including time); Geometry (including shapes and properties of triangles)</p>
Science	<p>First and Half Term: Biology: Living Things and their Habitats; Healthy lifestyles - healthy eating (to include digestive system); energy in food, benefits of exercise (Rolled over from Autumn) Second Half Term: Physics: Forces, Earth & Space (may roll over to Summer)</p>
K&U	<p>Geography: Settlements – needs of early settlers, resources, land scape, transport links History: Crime and punishment since Roman times. Comparisons across the key ages, justice systems etc. (some crossover themes with PSHCE)</p>
Creative	<p>Music - Electric Umbrella ongoing</p> <p>Art First Half-Term: Advertising - Study design of advertisements in different media. Create original designs of products, services and events to advertise in various media. Study and create accompanying graphic design, incl. IT. Self-assessment exercises, and Art homework. Second Half-Term: 20th Century Art Movements - Study of Impressionist movements and reproduction of artwork in the style of preferred artists. Impressionism – Cezanne, Degas, Monet & Renoir – featuring physical sensation, effects of light, movement, en plein air; bright colour. Continue Art homework and self-assessment of term's work.</p>

Food Technology	Pupils will plan, prepare and cook dishes from around the world. They will be involved in thinking about food groups, healthy eating and budgeting for meals whilst participating in hands-on Cooking sessions.
PE	First Half Term: Gymnastics Second Half Term: Table-Top Games
PSHCE	First half term: We will explore a unit called Amazing Me and look at issues that can affect how young people view themselves e.g. the role of social and wider media, celebrities and music culture etc. They will explore ways to evaluate and appreciate their own sense of self-worth and advice they can give to others. Second half term: British Values/Citizenship; rights & responsibilities, rules; cultural, religion & diversity
Computing	3D Modelling: Select, use and combine a variety of software (including Internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information by drawing and manipulating simple 3D shapes.
