Subject	Spring Term 2022
English	Book Study “Grandpa’s Great Escape’ by David Walliams Practising English skills Working on grammar, spelling, reading, writing, listening and speaking
Maths	A number of topics including: time, measurement (capacity), geometry, data analysis, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, patterns, fractions, directions, ratios, co-ordinates
Science	First and Half Term: Inheritance, adaptation and evolution Second Half Term: Rocks
ICT	Students will have the opportunity to create and use word documents and PowerPoints. They will learn about different computer programmes and use computerised cars.
PSHCE/RSHE	First half term: RSHE Second half term: British Values/Citizenship; rights & responsibilities, rules; Cultural, religion & Diversity
Creative	First half term Resistant Materials – Wood - Car Second half term Textiles – Tapestry Music- Exploring instruments, describe music using different vocabulary Drama- Using techniques to use their body and facial expressions to communicate and develop spatial awareness
Food Technology and Home Economics	Pupils will plan, prepare and cook dishes from around the world. They will be involved in thinking about food groups, healthy eating and budgeting for meals whilst participating in hands-on Cooking sessions.
K&U	History: Crime and Punishment through the ages RE: Learn about different Religious celebrations as they occur during the course of the term.

PE/Swimming	First half term: Gymnastics / Dance Second half term: Table-top games Pupils will work on individually set swimming target in timetabled swimming sessions
Forest School and Task Master	Students will get the opportunity to work with other classes to take part in Task-Master-type challenges and Forest-School activities. These help pupils develop problem-solving and thinking skills.
