Students' progress is recorded using the Winstrada development programme.</p>	

Outcomes to date:

Three members of staff were identified and signed up for the Train the Trainers Rebound Therapy course to be held on-site on 19th – 20th September 2017.

The outdoor learning for primary students is developing and the all-terrain wheelchairs and Aquabacs, which were purchased, will be put to use over the coming years.

The adapted PE equipment has helped to improve the quality of PE lessons.
