

Primary Elm KS1 &2 Class Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 2018

Subject	Autumn Term 1: Ourselves – The Five Senses / Autumn Autumn Term 2: Earth, Space and the Solar System
Literacy:	Individual and shared reading; O.R.T. Oxford Reading Tree, Bug Club, poetry, non-fiction texts. Recognising high frequency words, labels & captions, sentence construction; writing labels, sentences, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts, writing poetry based on poems read in class and personal experiences, blending phonemes to read words; rhymes; punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening; nouns; verbs; adjectives.
Numeracy	Counting; sorting; sequencing; matching, ordering; number bonds; doubles & halving, repeating addition/ multiplication; understanding symbols – addition, subtraction, real life problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, capacity using Non Standard Units of measurement, time – o’clock, half past, quarter past/to, hours and minutes, shape 2D /3D, pattern.
Science	Senses: Explore the five senses and how they use them to learn about the world around them. Link to exploring signs of autumn and their school environment. Earth, Space and the Solar system: be able to identify the earth from space including water, land and cloud. Know they see the stars and moon in the sky. Know day and night. Know that there are other planets in our solar system and the position of earth in relation to these and the sun.
Computing	Incorporated across all subjects within the curriculum.
PSHE	Protective Behaviours: Keeping safe, recognising feelings and emotions, identify what makes a good friend,
Art/ Design and Technology	Exploring different colours, textures and techniques including, painting, rubbings, splatter, printing. Exploring model making, joining and fixing techniques.
R.E.	Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education- Harvest, Sukkot, being thankful. Festivals of light – Diwali, Hannukah, Christmas
P.E/ Swimming	Swimming – Monday 1 Making Waves PE: Friday 1: focus on physio therapy targets, opportunities to practise aiming, throwing and catching different objects,
History/ Geography	Show awareness of change within their own life time. How their local environment changes with the seasons. Key features of planet earth – link with science
Music	Developing ability to control the sound of a range of instruments and body percussion, to stop and start in response to signals, expressing ideas and feelings about music; be able to identify and play a simple tune on tuned percussion. Explore songs and how they work as a round, explore how instruments add effects to music.
