

Primary KS2 - Koala Class - Curriculum Overview Spring Term 2020

Subject	Spring Term 1: Space Spring Term 2: Lights, Camera, Action
Literacy:	Individual and shared reading; O.R.T. Oxford Reading Tree, Bug Club, Fiction – Poems and class stories / Folk Tales, Non-Fiction – diaries. Recognising high frequency words, labels & captions, sentence construction; writing labels, sentences, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts; rhymes; punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening; Letters & Sounds: blending phonemes to read words. Researching information to make diary. Developing imagination and vocabulary to create own film/play.
Numeracy	Counting, sorting, sequencing, matching, ordering, number bonds, doubles & halving, repeating addition/ multiplication; understanding symbols – addition, subtraction, multiplication, division. Real life problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, length, weight and capacity using Non Standard Units of measurement and cm, mm, g, kg, ml and l., time – o’clock, half past, quarter past/to, hours and minutes, shape 2D /3D, pattern, fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$.
Science	Space- moon landing and craft, planets, moon, earth and sun, stars and constellations Lights, Camera, Action- light, sound, electricity
Computing	Incorporated across all subjects within the curriculum.
PSHCE	Safety- computer/internet safety, in the community
Art/ Design and Technology	1) Art- explore a range of forms to create a rocket 2) Textiles- make props and costumes for play
R.E.	Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education- Places of Worship, Festivals and Celebrations – Spring; Christian, Jewish, Islam, Hindu
P.E/ Swimming	Swimming – Thursday L3 Horseriding- Monday L2 PE- Wednesday L3- Jan to Feb only
History/ Geography	History- Show awareness of events that happened in past years- moon landing and recognise how they changed the way we understand things. Geography- Know places in relation to their home town
Music	Learn simple songs, keep a steady beat, name and use a variety of percussion instruments, create own combinations of sounds to create a space song. Contribute to Koala Class play script, song and music writing and performance.
