Research suggests that assessing creative thinking improves the quality of teaching by helping teachers to be clearer about what they are focusing on; raises the status of creativity in schools; and supports students to understand how they are progressing as they develop their creative thinking skills.

Rethinking Assessment (RA), in partnership the Australian Council for Education Research UK (ACER UK), are working on the research project to develop and evidence how UK schools embed and assess creative thinking within their curriculum. The focus of the research is to develop and test teaching and assessment practices for creative thinking.
