English	<p>First and Second Half Term: Class reader – Kensuke’s Kingdom – comprehension, punctuation, poetry, research, character profiles, lists, instructions, writing a letter, writing an invitation, predictions</p> <p>Reading, SPaG & phonics</p>
Maths	<p>First and Second Half Term: Number & Place value Measure</p>
Science	<p>First and Second Half Term: Pupils will be learning about light and the skeleton.</p>
K&U	<p>First and Second half term: Geog: What a Wonderful World Hist: Anglo Saxons & scots Geog: Our Changing World RE: Pilgrimages Mini topic: Christmas</p>
Food Technology	<p>Pupils will plan, prepare and cook dishes from around the world. They will be involved in thinking about food groups, healthy eating and budgeting for meals whilst participating in hands-on cooking sessions.</p>
PE	<p>First and Second half term: Ball skills – to develop hand / eye co-ordination Target games, including Boccia rules and simple tactics, team work. Some students will follow a program of study that will reflect their needs. This may include: walking, laying out, physio exercises, practical skills (such as ball skills and Boccia).</p>
Swimming	<p>Pupils will work on individually set swimming target in timetabled swimming sessions.</p>
PSHCE/Wellbeing	<p>First half and Second half term -Healthy Lifestyles – to develop understanding of what contributes to a healthy lifestyle and be able to distinguish between healthy and unhealthy practice.</p>
