- **Feedback on the term so far - WWW/EBI**

All classes were very positive about the introduction of morning snack. One class fed back that they would like healthier options and another said they would like sauce available with snacks. Everybody brought along positive feedback about the Macmillan Coffee Morning, saying they enjoyed it. Several groups feedback that they felt it was a little bit long and they would have preferred it to be around 45 minutes.
