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PRIMARY-

News

This week has been a week of love and kindness in Robin Class. We started the week Zooming to the moon to finish our Space Topic. We then used hearts to practice our shape recognition and counting. The class made some lovely heart art in Creative. Some of us chose to go to the Valentines Disco. In PSHE, we chose a friend to work and play with to practice our sharing and friendship skills. And in Cooking we made some American pancakes to share with our families.

Very fun week with Pancake Day and Valentine's day. The students designed a face pancake, then had a race. The children enjoyed the Valentine Disco, also making a card and a flower to take home. The children consolidated their learning on playing with and building different vehicles. In Science they enjoyed experiments, looking at glow in the dark stars and making bubble planets with bicarbonate of soda, food colouring and vinegar.

The highlight of the week was the Valentine Disco! The children iced their biscuits and made cards in Creative. We finished our Space Topic by acting out the planets orbiting the Earth. In Maths, the children used the vocabulary 'greater, less and equal' to compare two numbers. In English, the children were excited to receive a reply to their letter posted to the Aliens!

Dragonfly Class had a fantastic week finishing off our letters from Space! The class wowed us with their typing skills and worked so hard. We all enjoyed celebrating Pancake Day on Tuesday and Valentine's on Wednesday – especially the disco and the cards that were given and received. On Friday, we played some class games using the new 'magic mirror' and had a lot of fun working as a team. Have a lovely half term!

Falcon Class: In Literacy, we enjoyed listening to the Princess and the Pea story and answering comprehension questions. In Numeracy, we used scales to weigh objects and put them in order. In Geography, we discovered the parts of a river and how flooding occurs. We enjoyed looking at careers in the hospitality sector in Life Skills by booking hotel rooms and making beds. We enjoyed the 'Love Your Heart' workshop with Wombats and Sea Turtles and learning how to perform CPR.

Another busy week in Hippo Class. During the Maths sessions pupils looked at Statistics. The students learned that they could represent data in different ways including bar charts, pictograms and line graphs. Also, they enjoyed Valentine's Day Maths activities. They enjoyed the Valentine Disco this week and had great fun choosing some songs.

In English, the Class continued to do work on their computer game by planning the 'World' or setting of their game. They then used 'Paint' to design this on the computer in Computing. In Maths, they did some fun Valentine activities. In RS, they learnt about Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday and Lent. They also made some lovely cards for their Valentine! They loved the Valentine's Disco! Another exciting activity was the Basic Life Support workshop during which we learnt how to give CPR, how to use a defibrillator and how to put someone in the recovery position.

Gorillas have finished writing their own poems in English. They worked really hard to come up with creative, special things to put in their magical boxes.

In Maths, our class have gained so much confidence with weighing objects.

For an end of half term treat they did a science experiment creating cup and string phones!

Another busy week has flown by. On Monday, pupils practised their part in the assembly and delivered their words brilliantly – all about the story of St. Valentine. It was very romantic :) In English, they created their own mythical creature based on the Ancient Greek stories and will write their own back stories to the beasts. UPPER SCHOOL

This week, TD Class has been working hard to complete and finalise their topic work. In History, we learned about Howard Carter's emotions when he discovered the remarkable Tutankhamun's Tomb and wrote diary entries to express our understanding. In Geography, we investigated the effects of Chernobyl and how it impacted Eastern Europe. In English, we have been enhancing our spelling and writing skills, and it's making a significant difference. Lastly, in Art, we dived into the Mayan Cultures and explored the use of masks to represent the dead and pay tribute to them.

We had lots of fun this week during the Disco which took place on Wednesday afternoon. In Computing, we started our new Unit "Programming in Scratch" where we looked at Variables and Functions. In Science recapping on functional groups. In Maths, we recapped all the Algebraic topics that we have learned over this term. In English we were practicing our writing skills by writing "a letter to my son who is a drug addict"

We have had lots of fun making up silly poems using onomatopoeia in English. In Maths, we have been consolidating our learning of halves and quarters. In Science we made string telephones and in History we had a go at weaving, like the Anglo-Saxons. We also finished our Sound Unit in our Vocational lessons, clapping out rhythms and using tambourines.

Lynx enjoyed the Valentine Disco this week and had great fun choosing some songs. They also had a go at dissolving in Science and finished off their PSHCE unit with a quiz. In Maths, pupils looked at Statistics. The students learned that they could represent data in different ways including bar charts, pictograms and line graphs. 


