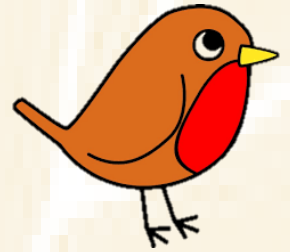




PRIMARY

News

Robin Class have continued 'Serena's Seasons' and this week focussed on Autumn,. They created their Autumn trees ready for their Science Week display. They enjoyed listening to natural sounds of the seasons which we have recorded for their display. In Maths, they continued their work on shapes and played a game of Shape Bingo and explored the shapes their light shadow had made. They also enjoyed spending time with Wombat Class on the Magic Carpet.



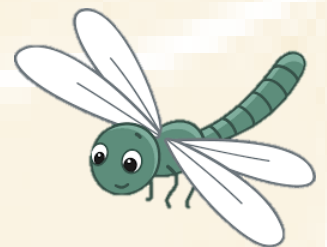

Monkey Class have worked on our materials experiment for Science Week. We tested which materials were best to make an umbrella for Ted. The pupils have also been measuring the rainfall for Geography. In Maths, they worked on division and sharing a given amount equally into groups. They listened to the story 'Rapunzel' in English, answering questions. They enjoyed Red Nose Day on Friday.

Alpaca Class have been measuring with CMs in Maths and listened to the story 'Little Red Riding Hood' in English. In Science, the children discovered whether they had made water solid by putting in the freezer last week. They learned lots of new words to use when describing materials. In K&U they have begun to learn about the water cycle. They have enjoyed sharing jokes for Comic Relief.

Dragonfly Class had a lovely week enjoying some learning in the sunshine! We have been labelling plants and trees by descriptions of their function and have had a great time preparing our story plans in English. We also started preparing our DT 'cam toy' projects, and even used saws to chop our dowels to the correct lengths. In PE, we have been exploring tabletop cricket and we were excited to see who wins next!

In English, we started to come up with our own endings to classic tales. In Maths, we developed our knowledge of subtraction and using the Bee-Bots to develop direction. In Science, we made posters for the Science Fair about all we've learnt so far about materials. In DT, we used tools to start making our cam toys. We enjoyed making the tallest book tower with Wombats and Sea Turtles in Task Master.



SECONDARY

News

This week the class have enjoyed making Stonehenge, as part of our K & U topic. The children painted the pieces of sponge and then carefully followed a picture to recreate the monument. In Maths, we continued to collect data using tally charts and used the collected information to make a bar chart of results. In Science, we have made a start on our Science Fair project by melting chocolate, and timing how long it takes! Lots of fun! We also enjoyed our first cycling session - thankfully, the rain stopped just in time!



WOMBAT CLASS

Hippo Class had a busy week. During Maths, they we have been learning about different fractions and how to find a fraction of a shape. The students looked at tenths and hundredths and tried to solve word problems with fractions. On the Red Nose Day, they had lots of fun and enjoyed telling jokes



HIPPO CLASS

We started the week by visiting the Sports Village at Hertfordshire University to take part in some sports activities. It was great fun. In PSCH, we continued to look at our emotions and did a task about 4 zones of emotion from feeling happy to feeling angry - looking at what it feels like to be in each zone and how we can help ourselves when we are in them. In Science, the class did a Spring walk looking at how things are changing now it is Spring. In Computing, the class continued to use Scratch to create a moving bug for Science week!



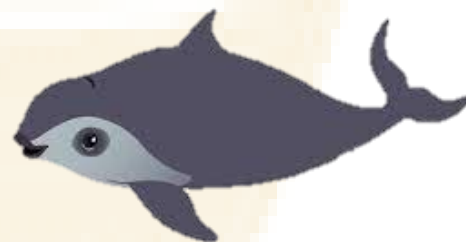
SEA TURTLE CLASS

The students tasted 4 different flavours and then used adjectives to describe them. In Science, we have been designing our own eco-friendly vehicles out of Lego! They will look amazing in our Science Week presentation! On Tuesday we went out cycling which the students really enjoyed and on Thursday, the Gorillas were brilliant in Open Orchestra!

This week in Science, students have been learning about thermal insulators/convectors. They have planned an experiment to see which materials keep ice from melting the longest (link to time theme for science week). In English, they developed their story plans and have begun to write them in more detail. In Maths, the money-based tasks continued and they discovered 'Fish is not as rich' this week.

This week in TD Class, we have been working extremely hard showcasing our learning. In Science, we looked back into the Archean Period to find out the elements of the atmosphere. In History, we looked at where the Mayan Civilisations still stand today and learn more about them. In Geography, we looked at how climate changes are caused and whether they are human or natural changes. In English, we have been creating and finding jokes for our 'Make SLT laugh' on Friday, we can't wait!

We had fun creating our own sweets in English, thinking about what strange things could happen like in Charlie and the Chocolate Factory! In Maths, we have been measuring different objects with a ruler and worked out how long two of them would be. We have enjoyed making our 3D seasons model in Science for the exhibition. In RE, we learnt about different Christian symbols and looked at a Bible, candlesticks and a candle. We loved telling jokes for Red Nose Day!

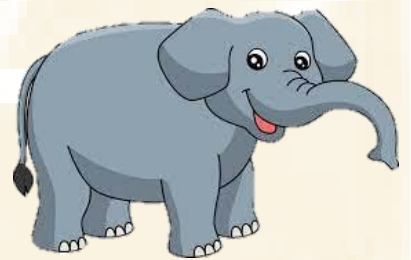

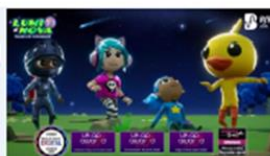

Kids eat for less or free this summer in Hertfordshire

Asda

Kids (aged 16 and under) eat for £1 at any time of day, seven days a week with no minimum spend.

Up to two kids can receive a free breakfast with one paying adult.

Kids aged 2-11 can eat for £1 at Bella Italia with the purchase of any adult main from 4-6pm Monday-Thursday.

Up to two kids can eat free all-day Monday – Friday if one adult orders any main dish.

Café Rouge

Kids eat for £1 with purchase of one adult main course. 22 July – 31 August. Excludes Saturdays.

Families can get one free kids' meal with every adult main meal purchased in the restaurant.

Kids eat free when an accompanying adult spends £4. Kids can get a mini main, two snacks and a drink.

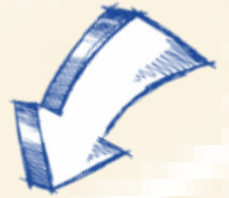
