Lonsdale School Uniform

Primary Pupils (Nursery to Year 6)

- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- White polo shirt
- Black, grey or royal blue jog pants/trousers or skirt
- Blue gingham dresses/skirts can be worn in the Summer Term

Secondary Pupils (Years 7 to 11)

- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- White polo shirt
- Black, grey or navy jog pants/trousers or skirt.

Post-16 Pupils (Years 12 and 13)

Pupils in Post-16 are not required to wear school uniform. However, all students are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate for a school setting. The following guidelines must be observed:

- Clothing should be modest, respectful, and suitable for a learning environment.
- Items with offensive, inappropriate, or suggestive language or imagery are not permitted.
- Footwear must be practical and safe; high heels and flip-flops are not allowed.
- Crop tops, clothing that exposes the midriff, excessively short skirts or shorts, and garments that reveal underwear should not be worn.
- Ripped or torn jeans, particularly those with large holes or significant fraying, are not acceptable.
- Piercings are permitted, provided they are limited to stud earrings or small hoops. Large hoops or spiked earrings are not allowed for safety reasons.
- Tattoos are permitted for students aged 18 and over, but must not display any offensive language, imagery, or content that promotes inappropriate views.

Students are expected to use good judgment and dress in a way that reflects the values of the school community.

We encourage sustainability through the reuse of school uniform. If you have clean, good-quality uniform items your child no longer needs, please drop them off at the school office in a bag clearly marked "**Second-Hand Uniform Donation.**" These items help support other families and reduce waste.

Non-Uniform Days (including Sports Week)

On designated non-uniform days, pupils are not required to wear school uniform. However, clothing must still be appropriate for school. The dress code outlined for Post-16 pupils applies to all students on these occasions.

Outdoor Learning

Due to the inclusion of outdoor learning as part of the curriculum, all pupils must have a **waterproof coat** available in school for use during outdoor lessons.

Spare Clothes

Please ensure your child has a spare set of clothing kept at school in a clearly labelled drawstring bag (please avoid using plastic bags). This should include:

- Underwear
- Socks
- Trousers
- A top

Swimming

As part of the school curriculum, your child will take part in timetabled swimming lessons. Please provide a swimming kit containing:

- Two towels
- A swimming costume
- Any Specialist swimwear (if appropriate).

In accordance with our Pool Safety Operating Procedure (PSOP), pupils who usually wear incontinence aids during the school day must wear protective swimwear in the water. This enables them to safely access swimming lessons.

Protective swimwear options include:

- Disposable swim nappies (readily available in smaller sizes at most supermarkets and online)
- Reusable, specialist incontinence swimwear (available online in a range of sizes)
