Subject	<p align="center">Autumn Term 1: Places, UK vs Australia Autumn Term 2: Seasons and Myths and Legends</p>
Literacy:	Individual and shared reading; O.R.T. Oxford Reading Tree, Bug Club, Fiction – Poems and class stories / Folk Tales, Non-Fiction – atlas, maps & plans - geography. Recognising high frequency words, labels & captions, sentence construction; writing labels, sentences, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts; rhymes; punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening; Letters & Sounds: blending phonemes to read words. Researching information to make non-fiction report. Developing imagination and vocabulary to create own stories.
Numeracy	Counting, sorting, sequencing, matching, ordering, number bonds, doubles & halving, repeating addition/ multiplication; understanding symbols – addition, subtraction, real life problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, coins, length, weight and capacity using Non Standard Units of measurement and cm, mm, g, kg, ml and l., time – o’clock, half past, quarter past/to, hours and minutes, shape 2D /3D, pattern, fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$.
Science	Seasonal changes, weather associated with the seasons.
Computing	Incorporated across all subjects within the curriculum.
PSHCE	Belonging – exploring our sense of ‘belonging’ to family, friendship groups, clubs etc. Being a good friend,
Art/ Design and Technology	1) Art- Using a range of materials to create a model of UK and Australian monuments 2) Textiles- make a tapestry
