



KS3 V Class - Curriculum Overview Summer Term 2020

Subject	Summer Term: The Coast
Literacy:	Poetry – compare types e.g limericks, rhyming, using the senses, Fiction, Non-Fiction – information texts, leaflets, postcards. Sentence construction; using speech in narratives, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts, using indexes & contents pages. Comparing fiction by same author/genres. Punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening;
Numeracy	Sequencing, ordinal numbers, number bonds, doubles & halving, multiplication; introduction to order of operations (Bidmas) – including word problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, length & weight temperature; fractions; time: 5m intervals, convert between analogue/digital, properties of shapes 2D /3D, pattern, directional language. Simple algebra. Translation and reflection in up to 4 quadrants. Data analysis – coastal themed/tourism
Science	Coastal habitats – beaches, rock pools, seas/oceans. Rocks – Types of coastlines, erosion & weathering, sea defences
ICT	Using online painting software to create images linking to the coasts theme – beaches, landforms etc.
PSHCE	Water/coastal safety, RNLI, Life guards Growth Mindset - The power of yet, what if?
Art/ Design and Technology	1) Coastal theme – different techniques, 2d & 3d, 2) Artist study – who uses water as their inspiration.
KU/RE/History/ Geography	Coasts: manmade/natural features & landforms, tourism, locations in Britain. Travel & industry. Waves/tsunamis/coastal flooding. Effects of sea levels rising.
