

**Primary KS2 - Owl Class - Curriculum Overview Autumn Term 2020**

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Autumn Term: Exciting Expeditions!</b>
<b>Literacy</b>	Individual and shared reading; O.R.T. Oxford Reading Tree, Bug Club, Fiction – Folk Tales from around the world, Non-Fiction – atlas, maps & plans - geography. Recognising high frequency words, labels & captions, sentence construction; writing labels, sentences, locating information in fiction and non-fiction texts, writing poetry based on poems read in class and personal experiences; rhymes; punctuation; spelling; handwriting (where applicable); speaking & listening; Letters & Sounds: blending phonemes to read words.
<b>Numeracy</b>	Counting, sorting, sequencing, matching, ordering, number bonds, doubles & halving, repeating addition/ multiplication; understanding symbols – addition, subtraction, real life problems; digit representations – ‘tens and units’; place value, coins, length & weight using Non Standard Units of measurement and cms, time – o’clock, half-past, quarter-past/to, hours and minutes, shape 2D /3D, pattern.
<b>Science</b>	Seasonal changes, weather associated with the seasons, Forces – push/pull, friction. Materials – types, properties
<b>Computing</b>	Incorporated across all subjects within the curriculum.
<b>PSHCE</b>	Changes to school environment and activities to help develop strategies to cope with changes. Friendship groups, belonging.
<b>Art/ Design and Technology</b>	1) Exploration: Pupils create 2D and 3D images and forms of Owls, learning to use a variety of media, techniques and materials. They will also learn facts and information about the life of owls. 2) Around the World: Pupils explore artwork and features from places around the world as inspiration for creating own images in various media. Christmas artwork: create Christmas-based images and designs, inc. Christmas Card scheme.
<b>RE</b>	Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education- Places of Worship, Festivals and Celebrations – Autumn & Winter; Christian, Jewish, Islam, Hindu. Purpose of prayer.
<b>PE/Swimming</b>	Swimming – Currently unavailable due to COVID restrictions, pupils will benefit from additional PSHCE sessions until swimming re-commences PE: Ball skills and target practise.
<b>History/ Geography</b>	Show awareness of change within their own life time. Changes in the travel Where we live – know their address, name of local town. Countries around the world- currency, language, flag Some historic explorers – how they travelled, where they went, what they found.
<b>Music</b>	Learn simple songs, keep a steady beat, name and use a variety of percussion instruments, create own combinations of sounds to enhance a song or story. Listen to music and songs by different composers.
<b>Food Technology and Home Economics</b>	Preparation of Macmillan Coffee Morning (Sep 2020), planning recipes, preparing dishes and baking cakes food and hygiene theory, learning to use equipment safely and learning new skills
